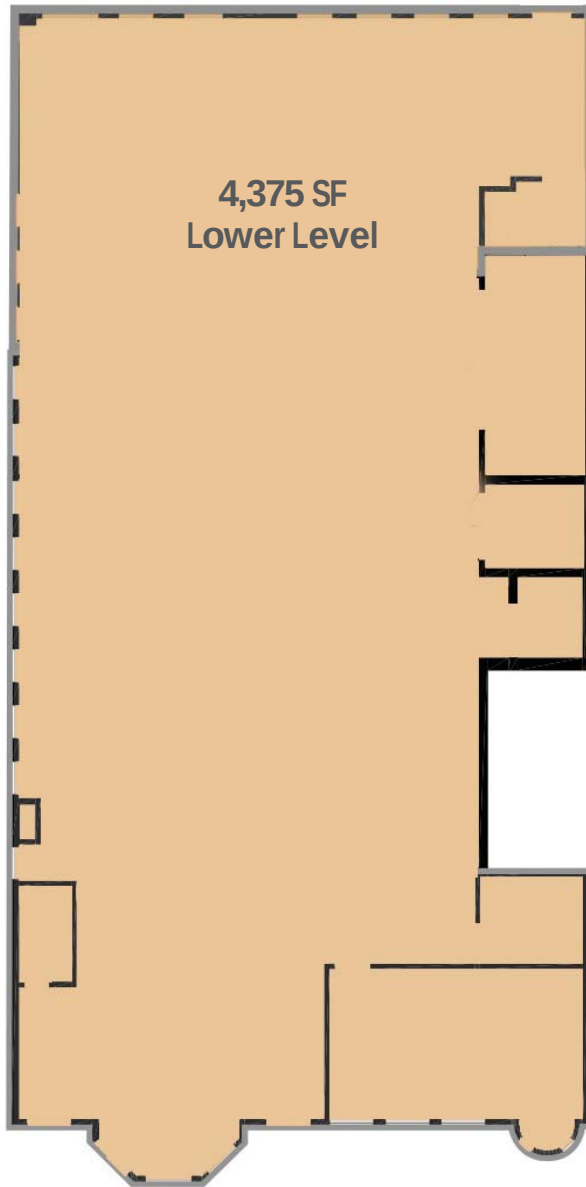
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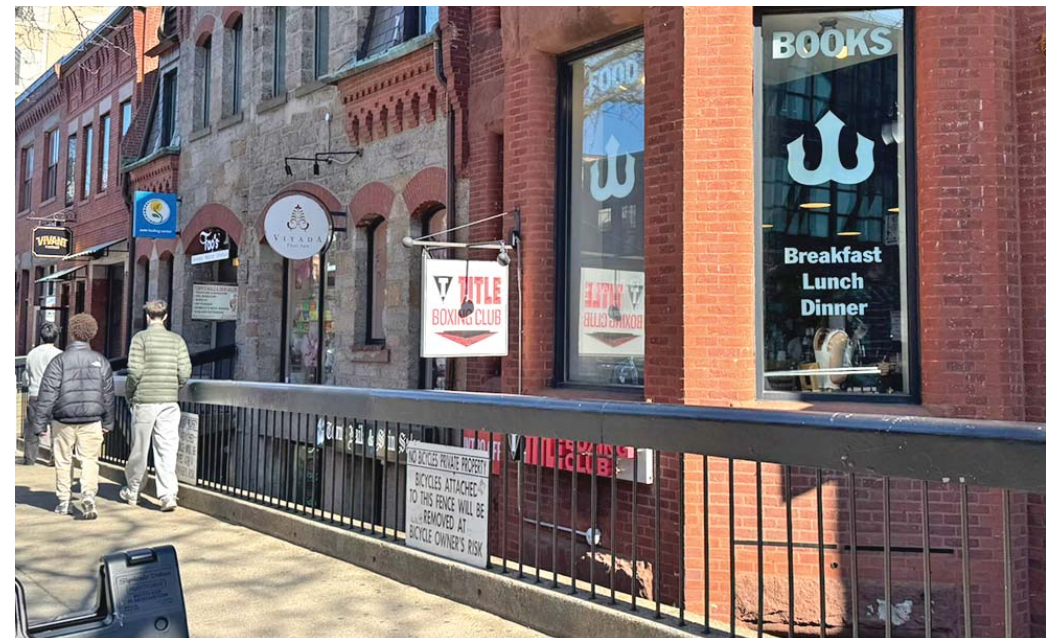

NEWBURY STREET

Newbury Street, the “Rodeo Drive of the East”, known for its international boutiques, salons, cafes, and restaurants, is one of the top shopping destinations in the US and one of the most popular visitor attractions in Boston.

BACK BAY

The Back Bay, along the Charles River, is known for its elegant row houses and brick sidewalks. The Commonwealth Avenue Mall and riverside Esplanade feature recreation, concerts, and festivals. Boylston Street and Huntington Avenue are lined with retailers, hotels, restaurants, and office buildings, including **Prudential Center** and **Copley Place**. The Hynes Convention Center attracts meetings and conferences to the heart of the city.



FENWAY/KENMORE SQUARE

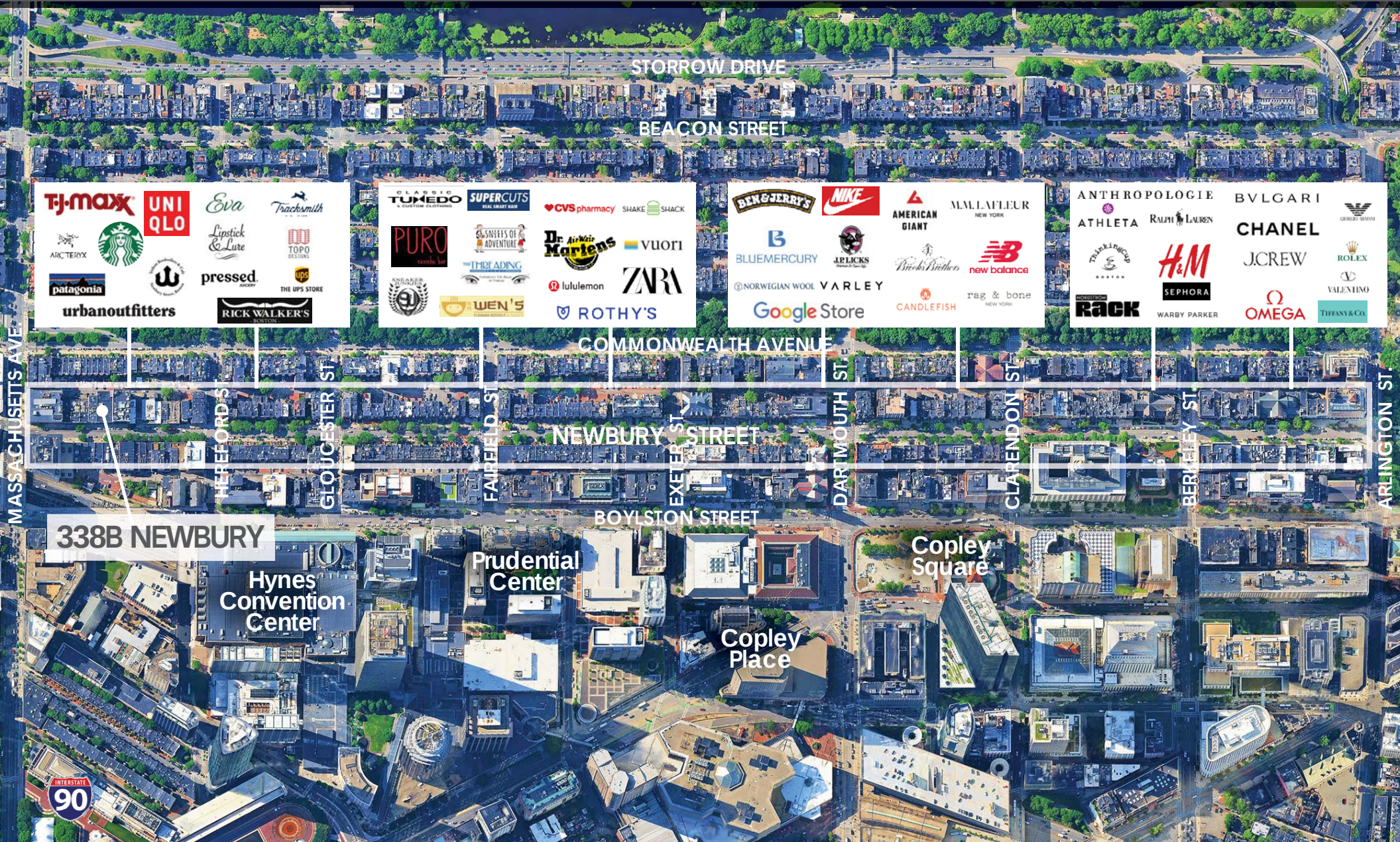

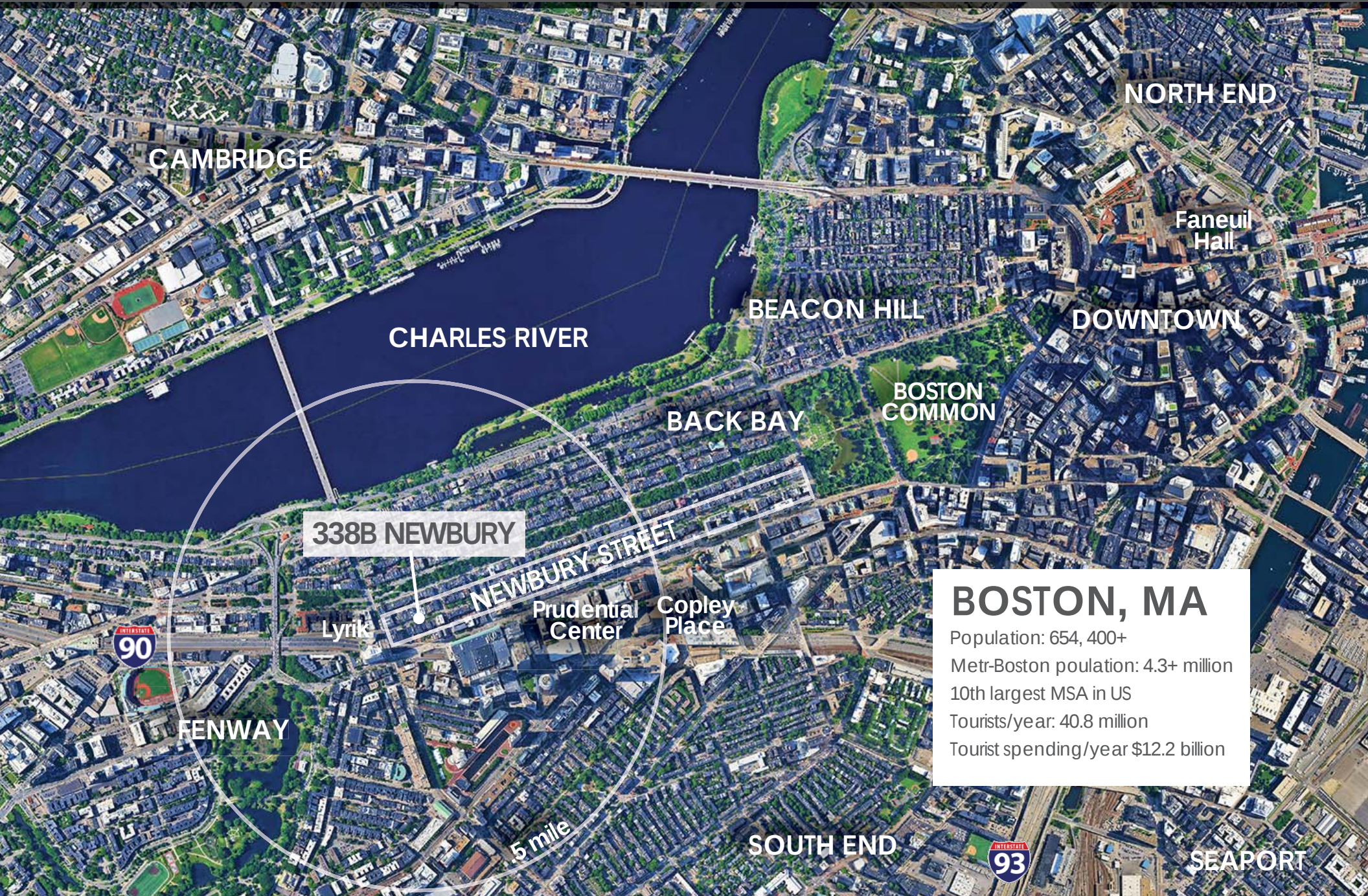
